### 2025/26 Instrumental Music Training Scheme of the Music Office Recruitment for Elementary Year-1 Courses

With a current enrolment of almost 4,400, the Instrumental Music Training Scheme (IMTS) of the Music Office offers its trainees a comprehensive course of instrumental music training, inclusive of musicianship★ and music theory.

The Music Office is now recruiting trainees for its 2025/26 IMTS Elementary Year-1 Courses. Target participants of the **two-year elementary** instrumental music training courses are young people with no instrumental experience on the selected instrument. Weekly one-hour group lessons including teaching, record of homework, instrument preparation, tuning and packing, are conducted in Cantonese at a designated music centre. Annual tuition fees - HK\$2,394 for Year-1 courses and \$2,926 for Year-2 courses, are payable in 4 instalments. Please see inside pages for class schedules and age requirements.

Statistics from past recruitments have reflected a higher admission rate for the following instrumental classes: Viola, Double Bass, Suona, Sheng, Zhongruan, Sanxian, Percussion (Chinese), Cello (Chinese Music), Double Bass (Chinese Music), Bassoon, French Horn, Trombone, Tuba and Euphonium.

#### **Application Procedures**

- 1. Online application: Applications should be submitted through the Music Office website 
  (<a href="https://www.lcsd.gov.hk/en/mo/training/instrumentalmusictrainingscheme.html">https://www.lcsd.gov.hk/en/mo/training/instrumentalmusictrainingscheme.html</a>) on or before 4 August 2025. Applicants will receive an acknowledgement receipt with an application number upon completion of the online application. The same acknowledgment of receipt will also be emailed to the applicant thereafter (Please check all mailboxes, including inbox, junk and spam mail to avoid misdeliveries). Applicants who have not received the acknowledgement receipt should consider their application unsuccessful and submit a new application. In case of doubt, they can call the music centre where their first-choice class will be held on the next working day.
- 2. By post / in person: The completed application form, together with 3 self-addressed envelopes stamped with sufficient postage should be sent by mail or submitted in person to the music centre where the applicant's first-choice class will be held on or before 4 August 2025. Please note that (i) applications submitted by post must include a clearly written return mailing address on envelope; (ii) applications postmarked after the application deadline will not be considered; (iii) faxed, emailed or late applications will not be accepted. Applicants who have not received any acknowledgement of receipt of application by post or email by 7 August 2025 should contact the music centre where their first-choice class will be held.
  - # As applicants who have provided an email address on the application form will receive all notifications by email, there is no need for them to enclose any self-addressed envelopes in their applications.

#### **Admission Test**

- 1. Applicants who meet the age requirement (please see age range as listed in class schedule) will be invited to attend an admission test which comprises a music aptitude test and an interview on 24 August 2025 (Note: No alternative day for the test). Applicants who do not meet the age requirement of their chosen class(es) will be disqualified.
- 2. Applicants can check their assigned admission test session through the Music Office website if no notification letter is received by 18 August 2025.
- 3. Selection is based on applicants' order of class choices and their admission test scores (That is, should there be vacancies left after selection of applicants' first choice class according to their admission test scores, selection for their second choice class will be considered).
- 4. Applicants will be notified of their application results in October. They can also check their application results at the Music Office website from 15 October 2025 onwards.
- 5. Applicants should contact the music centre where their first-choice class will be held if they have any questions about the admission test.

#### **Notes for Applicants**

- 1. The elementary courses are only suitable for individuals with no prior training on the selected instrument.
- 2. Age is calculated as at 1 September 2025.
- 3. <u>Each applicant should submit only 1 application</u>, otherwise, he/she will be disqualified. Successful applicants can only enrol in one instrumental class of the scheme.
- 4. Applications from trainees enrolled in the 2024/25 Instrumental Music Training Scheme will not be considered. Exceptions: 2024/25 Grade E-2,Grade I-3 and Grade A-3 trainees.
- 5. Successful applicants will commence training in November 2025 in accordance to the class schedule and venue listed in the notification. (Note: No application for class transfer will be considered in the first year of study.)
- 6. Except for a few loan scheme instruments (bassoon, alto saxophone, oboe, french horn, trombone, tuba and euphonium/baritone) and bulky instruments (harp and double bass) to be available in music centres, all trainees must equip with their own instruments for practice and class use (Chinese and Western Percussion trainees are also required to bring their own percussion kit). Yangqin and zheng will be provided for class use, however, trainees must equip with the instruments for home practice.
- 7. Trainees with financial difficulties can apply for fee remission, but would need to continue their payment of tuition fees until their applications have been approved. Deadline for applications: 31 December 2025. All applications must be accompanied by relevant document proofs such as valid certificates issued by the Student Finance Office or the Social Welfare Department for assessment of subsidy level.
- 8. Successful applicants should not be enrolled in any courses of the same instrument at tertiary institutions (including the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts junior programmes) learning the same instrument(s) simultaneously, otherwise, he/she will be disqualified.
- 9. The Music Office reserves the right to change instructors and venues, and cancel/adjust training class schedules.
- 10. The Music Office reserves the final right to interpret and amend the above terms and conditions.
  - ★ All Elementary Year-2 trainees have to take elementary Musicianship course to help enhance their music learning efficiency.
