Points to Note	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. A person-in-charge aged 18 or above or a teacher should be designated to oversee the activities.2. Participants should wear proper sportswear and sports shoes.3. Tenpin Bowling is available under the Sport Captain Programme. Please refer to the respective prospectus for details. (P.187)4. If the NSA has arranged a coach for a school and the school requests before the activity date the cancellation of the activity, NSA will deduct from the fee for each activity an administrative fee (\$210 per Sport Demonstration; \$420 per training course under the Outreach Coaching Programme) and refund the balance to the school. If the request to cancel the Sport Demonstration is made by the school on the day of the activity, no re-scheduling or make-up session will be arranged. All fees paid will not be refunded.5. The fees for Sport Demonstration (At Bowling Alley) and training courses under the Outreach Coaching Programme are used for the advance booking of bowling alleys, including the hiring charges for bowling shoes and lanes. If the NSA has arranged a Sport Demonstration (At Bowling Alley) for a school and the school subsequently requests the cancellation of the activity, no re-scheduling or make-up session will be arranged. All fees paid will not be refunded. As regards the training courses under the Outreach Coaching Programme, if the NSA has arranged a course for a school and the school subsequently requests its cancellation, the NSA will deduct, on a pro rata basis, the fee for the first lesson from the course fee and refund the balance to the school.6. If the NSA/LCSD fails to arrange the activity, the fees paid will be refunded.
