Participants must complete the courses at lower levels and pass the relevant assessment before they can move on to higher level courses. After its students have completed the Three-star Award level in the Kayak Elementary Training Course, each school may nominate up to 16 of the students to form a school team, which will receive training for a period of 4 to 6 months as well as regular skills assessment.</li> <li>Upon completion of kayak training course under the Easy Sport Programme or Outreach Coaching Programme, an assessment will be conducted by the coach according to various levels of badges standards of canoe. Participants who meet the required standard may obtain the badges and certificates according to their achieved levels from the NSA at their own cost.
