Participants who meet the required standard may obtain the certificates and badges according to their achieved levels from the NSA at their own cost (\$20 for Elementary certificate, \$30 for Intermediate certificate, \$50 for Advanced certificate, \$50 for Bronze badge, \$80 for Silver badge and \$100 for Gold badge). 4.
