〈 Orienteering 〉

Objective: To establish clear technical standards for orienteering through a tiered assessment system, enabling students to gauge their own proficiency, set personal goals, and progressively improve their skills.

Badge Levels:	Credential Level	Assessment Items	Passing Criteria
	Bronze (Basic Park Orienteering)	ISSprOM orienteering map and legend, map setting skills, control points and use of punches, cross-country and score orienteering experience competitions	Please refer to Annex
	Silver (Advanced Park Orienteering)	Advanced map setting skills and basic compass use, contour line reading and orienteering skills application, identification of International Control Description Symbols, use of electronic punching equipment	
	Gold (Introductory Orienteering)	ISOM orienteering map and legend, map setting skills, contour line reading and basic orienteering skills application, cross-country competition, etc.	

Participation and Award: Participants of the orienteering training courses of the “Sports Experience Programme”, the “Outreach Coaching Programme” and the “Joint Schools Training Programme” under the School Sports Programme will be assessed by their coach against the badge requirements at the end of the course. Those who meet the required standards will be awarded a badge and certificate by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) as an encouragement.

Collection of Certificates: Teachers are required to return the “Record of Assessment by Individual” and the “Record of Assessment by Coach” to the LCSD within one week of the assessment. Upon verification, the badges and certificates will be sent to the schools by post for teachers to distribute to qualified participants.

School Sports Programme – Badges Award Scheme

Badge Requirements for Orienteering

Bronze (Basic Park Orienteering)

- Eligibility: Participants of the Park Orienteering Level 1 Training Course (POL) under the Sports Experience Programme / Joint Schools Training Programme
- Requirements: Complete the POL training components under the coach's guidance and successfully finish a park orienteering experience competition within the time limit.

Silver (Advanced Park Orienteering)

- Eligibility: Holders of the Bronze Badge participating in the Park Orienteering Level 2 Training Course (POL2) under the Sports Experience Programme / Joint Schools Training Programme
- Requirements: Complete the POL2 training components under the coach's guidance and successfully finish a park orienteering experience competition within the time limit.

Gold (Introductory Orienteering)

- Eligibility: Holders of the Silver Badge participating in the orienteering training course under the Outreach Coaching Programme (equivalent to the Orienteering Level 1 Training Course)
- Requirements: Complete the fundamental orienteering training components under the coach's guidance and successfully finish an orienteering experience competition within the time limit.
