**2025/26 Outreach Coaching Programme - Wushu Competition**  
**Prospectus**

- 1. Objective:** To offer participants of the “Outreach Coaching Programme – Wushu” under the School Sports Programme (SSP) more opportunities for exchange of skills and experience with a view to cultivating their interest in wushu and enhancing their skills.
- 2. Date:** 20 December 2025 (Saturday)
- 3. Time:** 9:00 am – 1:00 pm
- 4. Venue:** Shun Lee Tsuen Sports Centre (Address: No. 33, Shun Lee Tsuen Road)
- 5. Eligibility and Quota:** The competition is open to all primary and secondary school students in Hong Kong. Entry is limited to 40 teams from schools only. Priority will be given to schools which participated in the “Outreach Coaching Programme – Wushu” under the SSP during the period September 2023 to August 2025. Participants must be current students of their schools during the competition. Each school can enter a maximum of the three teams. Applications will be processed on a first-come-first served basis. If there are remaining places, applications from primary and secondary schools which did not participate in the said programme will be considered.
- 6. Divisions and Events:** Each Participating team can register for at most 1 Basic event, 1 Quanshu, 1 Short weapon and 1 Long weapon.

Primary Division and Secondary Division	(1) Basic event (choose one): A. Movements of the Youth Wushu Badges Award Scheme Levels 1 to 2 B. Movements of the Youth Wushu Badges Award Scheme Levels 3 to 4 C. Movements of the Youth Wushu Badges Award Scheme Levels 5 to 6 The standards for the above movements are set out in the Hong Kong, China Wushu Union Limited’s guide to the Youth Wushu Badges Award Scheme.
	(2) Optional routine (Quanshu / Short weapon / Long weapon): A. Quanshu i. Wubuquan ii. Elementary Changquan style 1 levels 1 and 2 iii. Elementary Nanquan B. Short weapon i. Elementary Jianshu ii. Elementary Daoshu C. Long weapon i. Elementary Gunshu ii. Elementary Qiangshu

**7. Time Limit for Performance and Number of Participants:**

Event	Time limit *	Number of participants per team
Basic event	Not more than 1 minute and 10 seconds	4 to 8 persons
Optional routine		At least 2 persons

\*Participants must complete all the movements within the time limit, or marks will be deducted.

- 8. Fee:** \$130 per team

- 9. Notes on Enrolment:**
- (1) Participating teams may be composed of all boys, all girls or mixed.
  - (2) Number of participants per team should be 4 to 8 persons.
  - (3) A separate application form is required for each team. Please photocopy the form if necessary.
  - (4) No change can be made to the event(s) entered or the participants list once the application form is accepted. If a team is found to have fielded any participant who is not on the list during the competition, the team will be disqualified.

**10. Application Period:** ***From now until 7 November 2025 (Friday) (The postmark date will be deemed the date of submission)***

**11. Enrolment:** The duly completed application form, together with a crossed cheque payable to “Hong Kong China Wushu Union Limited”, should be sent to the School Sports Programme Unit, 1/F, Leisure and Cultural Services Headquarters, 1-3 Pai Tau Street, Sha Tin by post, with “2025/26 Outreach Coaching Programme - Wushu Competition” marked on the envelop.

**12. Awards:**

A. Team Event

- There will be award(s) for each event. The number of awards depends on the number of participation teams in each event for each division:

Number of participating teams	Number of awards
10 or above	The champion and 1 <sup>st</sup> to 5 <sup>th</sup> runners-up will be awarded.
7 - 9	The champion and 1 <sup>st</sup> to 3 <sup>rd</sup> runners-up will be awarded.
4 - 6	The champion, 1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> runners-up will be awarded.
3	The champion and 1 <sup>st</sup> runners-up will be awarded.
2	The champion will be awarded.
1	The team will be presented with a merit award upon achieving the standards set by the Organiser.

- Teams with award(s) will receive a trophy, and each team member will receive a certificate. The schools of the teams with award(s) will be informed of the arrangements for the collection of certificates in due course.

B. School Active Participation Award

- The award will present to the School with overall highest Participation.

***The award presentation ceremony will be held immediately after the completion of the event.***

**13. Judges/ referees:** The Hong Kong, China Wushu Union Limited will provide judge/referee services.

**14. Rules:**

- (i) The size of the competition area is 14m x 8m.
- (ii) Participants shall wear non-marking sports shoes and proper sportswear.
- (iii) Participants shall comply with the rules and regulations set by the Organiser and the venue.
- (iv) Leaders of the teams shall report to the Organiser 30 minutes before the scheduled time for the match. Participants shall turn up outside the competition area 15 minutes before the scheduled event time for roll call made by the judges. Those who fail to turn up for the roll call will be deemed to have withdrawn from the competition.
- (v) In case of a serious breach of the rules and regulations of the competition or display of unsporting behavior by a participant, the Organiser reserves the right to disqualify him/her from the rest of the competition and order the team to leave the venue.
- (vi) The Organiser reserves the right to change the competition schedule in consideration of the actual situation. On-the-spot announcement of the schedule shall be final.
- (vii) Unless explicitly stated in this prospectus, the rules and regulations laid down by the International Wushu Federation will be adopted.
- (viii) When the Air Quality Health Index (AQHI) reaches “Serious” (band 10+) at the general station of the affected district where the competition is being held (i.e. Kwun Tong District), all events in progress should be stopped immediately.
- (ix) The Organiser will take photographs/videos/audios during the activities, and reserves the right to display/publish these materials on the Internet, at LCSD venues, on the Organiser dedicated website, in publications and through other publicity channels for promotion or record purposes.

**15. Appeal:**

The decisions of the judges/referees on the spot shall be final. No appeal shall be accepted.

**16. Inclement Weather****Arrangements:**

If Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above or Red/Black Rainstorm Warning Signal has been issued by the Hong Kong Observatory, or the AQHI reaches “Serious” (band 10+), school children at the district where the competition is to be held (i.e. Kwun Tong District), or class suspension has been announced by the Education Bureau 2 hours before the commencement of the first event on the competition day, all events on that day will be cancelled. Participants will be notified of the subsequent arrangements in due course. Other than the above mentioned adverse weather conditions, all participants are required to report to the Organiser as scheduled. The judges/referees on the spot will decide whether the competition should proceed as scheduled or not.
